HOW DOES A CHILD QUALIFY?

A child may qualify for concurrent care when:

- They are facing a serious or life-limiting illness and continue to receive curative or life-prolonging treatments.
- The family desires added support to manage care at home and coordinate between multiple providers.
- The child could benefit from regular symptom management, emotional support, or extra care planning.

Concurrent care allows your child to receive medical treatment and hospice-level support at the same time — ensuring comfort, quality of life, and continued hope.
